RECOMMENDED HOUSE WINE

Venta del Quijote Sauvignon Blanc (Spain)

Attractive to the nose, marked by peach, mandarin and other citric fruits aromas that mix with sweeter sensations like honey and tropical fruits

14270 Moreau Blanc (France) €25.00

Made from a blend including Sauvignon Blanc grapes from the Loire Valley, this is a very refreshing dry wine with delicious apple fruit flavours on the palate.

4334 Sibarita, Sauvignon Blanc (Chile) €25.00

Notes of white flowers, particularly jasmine, blending in mouth with citrus tangs (lemon and a touch of lime), honeydew melon and peach hints. Balanced, classy and clean-cut.

5922 Red Belly Black Chardonnay (Australia) €27.00

A lively, crisp and clean all-purpose dry white wine with rich texture, Tangy citrus and ripe melon flavours, a creamy texture and robust fruit Flavours are present.

8283 Sauvignon Blanc, Vin de Pays d'Oc Baron Philippe de Rothschild €26.00

From a renowned producer, this wine shows ripe citrus and slightly tropical fruit aromas, full bodied and soft with a clean, refreshing finish.

3710 Chenin Blanc - Villiera Estate (South Africa) €25.00

The wine has intense fruit with a touch of wood spice on the nose, including guava and citrus. On the palate it is rich and full bodied with good balance and a long finish.

3911 Muscadet de Sevre-et-Maine Sur Lie €28.00

Chateau de la Cassemichere (France)
Dry and fresh wine with excellent fruit. Clean finish.

3944 Montes Reserva Chardonnay (Chile) €27.00

A fresh wine, fruity with good body and balance, creamy and complex in mid palate with nice elegant finish.

4341 Pinot Blanc Cuvee Les Amours - F.E. Hugel et Fils (Alsace) €28.00

Dry, yet very refreshing, delicate with nice fruit. It has wide appeal as a lovely easy drinking style wine.

1194 Masi Masianco Pinot Grigio (Italy) €33.00

Made predominantly from the Pinot Grigio grape this is a modern white wine with character and style. The palate is full, rich and dry with a delicate vanilla note on the finish.

8956 De Wetshof, Bon Vallon Chardonnay (South Africa) €29.00



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An unwooded Chardonnay matured on the lees, producing a fresh, lemony flavoured wine with a yeasty nutty aftertaste.

Graffigna, Pinot Grigio (Argentina)

€25.00

A wine greenish yellow in tone with acierated reflections. Its floral bouquet, emphasising white flowers and fruits like peach tree and apricot is matched on the palate with very fresh yet subtle floral notes; young fruited with a pleasant end.

1805 Saint Claire Sauvignon Blanc (New Zealand)

€32.00

St Clair's award-winning Sauvignon Blanc is made in the Marlborough region of New Zealand. The wine has intense gooseberry fruit flavours, yet elegant with a long refreshing finish.

Waterford Chardonnay

€36.00

Nutty, elegant toast on the nose. Clean, fresh lemon and lime notes. Grapefruit, lime & Juicy kiwi fruit on the palate. Understated, rich finesse, restrained by refreshing acidity. A long elegant finish

2127 Crozes Hermitage Blanc Les Meysonniers (France)

€35.00

This is a beautifully fresh dry subtle wine with nice touches of almonds on the nose.

Stoneleigh, Marlborough Sauvignon Blanc (New Zealand)

€33.00

This wine displays a fragrant bouquet of passion fruit and dry grass aromas with a palate of rich, ripe passion fruit and clean, crisp apple flavours.

2769 Macon Lugny, Louis Jadot (France)

€36.00

Macon Lugny is a beautiful lively, fresh wine and can be distinguished by its aromas of apple and white flowers with hints of lemon.

8737 Sancerre, Jean Max Roger (France)

€45.00

Beautiful aromatic bouquet, with fresh appetising fruit, full and ripe with zippy acidity.

RECOMMENDED UPGRADE

Sancerre –Domaine Du Nozay (France)

€45.00

This is a dry, flinty and acidic wine made from the Sauvignon Blanc grape, with a gorgeous bouquet of flowers, gooseberries and lime tones.

8970 Neil Ellis Groenekloof Sauvignon Blanc (South Africa)

€37.00

A complex, characterful wine, with ripe tropical fruit and subtle herbaceous tones leading to a long, flavourful finish. This has everything one expects from a New World Sauvignon. Rated as one of South Africa's finest.

8726 Pouilly Fumé, Domaine Chatelain (France)

€40.00

A well made Pouilly Fumé with aromas of gooseberries, blackcurrants and asparagus. On the palate experience true fruit flavours and the



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renowned zesty liveliness.

- 2314 **Chablis - J. Moreau et Fils (France)** €42.00
Made from the Chardonnay grape, it is green gold, aromatic, elegant with well balanced dryness.

Premium White Wines

- Chablis A.C Albert Pic (France)** €47.00
Yellow in color, with greenish tints. On the nose, distinguished mineral notes with a slight fruitiness. On the palate, the wine is fresh and tastes of minerals. It is large and round. The finish has notes of toast and a hint of vanilla.

- 2794 **Chablis 1er Cru Vaillon, J Moreau et Fils (France)** €60.00
This unoaked style of Chablis is dry, crisp and firm with a beautiful balance of fruit and a long finish.

- 2501 **Chassagne Montrachet – Louis Jadot (France)** €85.00
Superb full bodied rich wine which shows a vigorous earthy finish. This is a truly to single estate wine.

Venta del Quijote Tempranillo (Spain)

Red cherry colour with purple tones, garnet border and medium-high intense colour. Very tasty and with body, its tannins are polished and friendly

- 14240 **Moreau Rouge (France)** €25.00
From the Languedoc region in Southern France, the blend of Carignan and Syrah grapes produce a fruity easy drinking wine with ripe, spicy flavours.
- 4337 **Sibarita, Merlot (Chile)** €25.00
The nose offers fruit notes of plums and blackberries, alongside rich traces of liquor bonbons, chocolate and mocha. To the palate it's silky yet firm and structured, fulfilling and persistent.
- 5921 **Red Belly Black Shiraz (Australia)** €27.00
Deep purple with brooding red hues, this rich full bodied wine shows ripe plum, cherry and licorice fruit on the nose. Ideal with your favourite red meat or hearty pasta dishes.
- 8276 **Cabernet Sauvignon, Baron Philippe de Rothschild Vin de Pays d'Oc (France)** €26.00



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The high proportion of Merlot in the assemblage gives this delightful AC Bordeaux a lovely fruity, lively, soft style with gentle tannins that make it so enjoyable.
